

#### MOOSE CHARITIES UPDATE

Moose Charities is responsible for tracking donations from the Lodges and Chapters in support of Mooseheart and Moosehaven. In addition, they ask individual members to give directly in support of the children and seniors.

There are several ways that individual members are able to help. By making an annual donation of as little as \$10 or more, you can become a **Mooseheart Booster** in support of the children at Mooseheart.

The **Donors Circle** is a recognition program for individual members who give directly to Moose Charities. Donors are recognized with a series of pins and recognition by Association on the Moose Charities website.

In 2015 the **Moosehaven Centennial Project** was introduced to build a new residential home for our senior members. Lodges, Chapters, and Moose Legions are all sending donations to Moose Charities but individuals can also send donations to help with this project.

The **m & m Club** is a recognition program whereby individual members can make a monthly contribution to Moose Charities and can designate where your donation is credited.

The **League of Guardians** is a recognition program for donors and their spouses whose combined giving to Moose Charities totals \$1000 or more during the fiscal year, May 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>. New York State is fortunate to have 20 members in the League of Guardians. Moose Charities recognizes these members with a dinner at the International Convention each year and with a special listing in the Annual Report.

Please remember that 100% of your individual donations go directly to the project of your choice and your donations are tax deductible.
