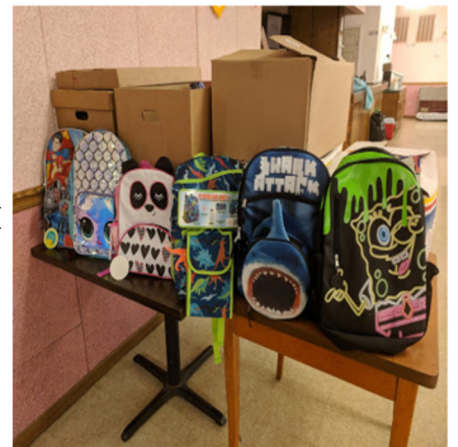

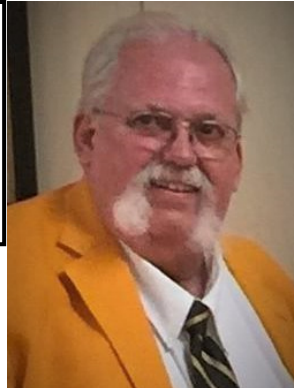

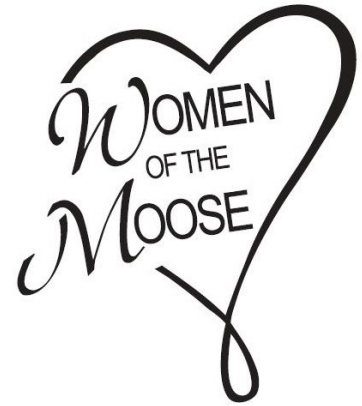

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

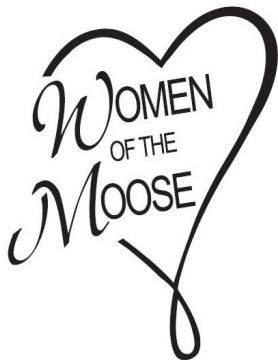
I cannot believe this year has passed already.

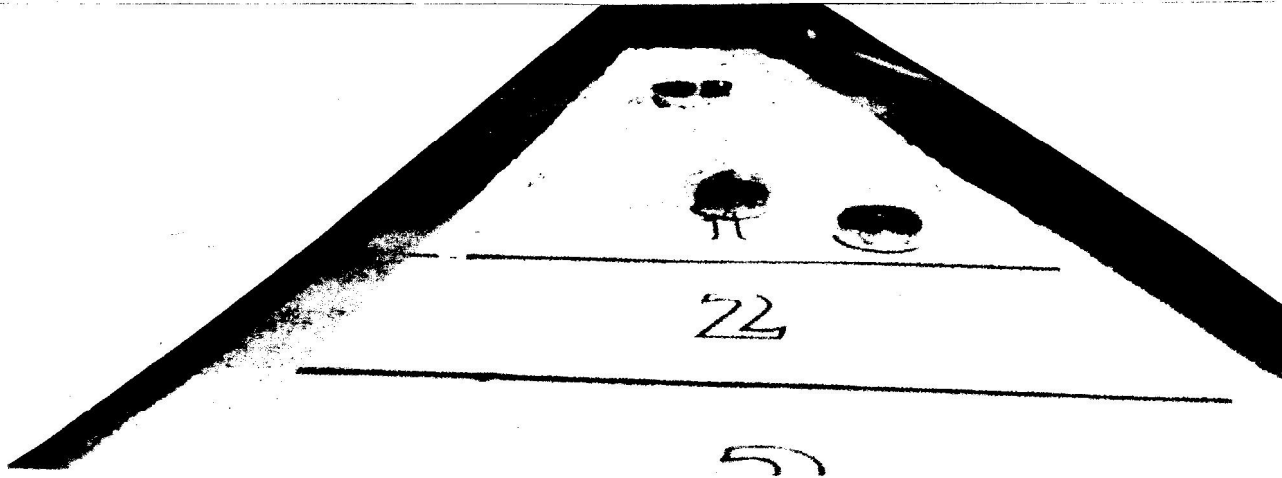

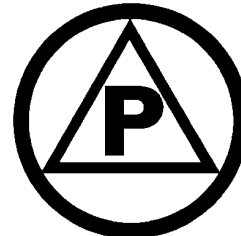
