Summer months are always very busy for all of us, as we try to squeeze in as much as we can before the snow flies, so I hope that you can all make it to Western NY for our Annual Convention.

I'm sure that you have all been getting out in your communities to see what you can do! Warm weather allows us to tackle some of those much-needed projects like highway cleanups, lawn mowing, building repairs and many other things that are difficult to do in the colder months. Many Lodges are holding outdoor events to raise money for their communities. There's Bike Rallies, Meat Raffles, picnics and other fun things going on at our Lodges. If your lodge is planning something, make sure that you share the information, as others would likely be interested in attending and donating.

Our HOC project at Binghamton in April was a great success. With the food and monetary donations combined, the representatives from CHOW reported that our donations yielded 6147 meals for the Broome County area! Thank you to everyone that donated!

At Niagara Falls, our HOC project will be in support of Niagara County Child Protective Services (CPS). They are asking for gift card donations, preferably from TOPS or WALMART in \$10 and \$20 value. These cards will be for emergency purposes and given to social workers that are called in to help families in crisis. The social worker will purchase items to help the family get through the situation. CPS will also be very happy to receive donations of BABY DIAPERS and BABY FORMULA. Due to storage limitations, these are the only supply items they are asking for. Monetary donations will also be accepted, with **checks made payable to NYSMA**, and we'll see that the above items are purchased and donated to CPS.

The next quarterly HOC Report is due by August 15th. Administrators make sure you get it done and in on time to receive the much-deserved credit for all that you do for so many others! Chapters keep submitting your information on your monthly 114 Reports. Hours volunteered and miles driven by members as well as all monies donated should all be reported.
